

Sen. Heidi Balderree represents Senate District 22, covering much of Utah County, including parts of Lehi, Saratoga Springs and Eagle Mountain, as well as a sliver of Draper in Salt Lake County. Sen. Balderree was elected in a special election to the Senate in October of 2023 and was re-elected in 2024. She is a co-chair of the Public Education Appropriations Subcommittee and serves on the Senate Education Committee, the Senate Judiciary, Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee and the Social Services Appropriations Subcommittee.

Before joining the Senate, Sen. Balderree was active in Republican Party leadership, serving multiple times as a precinct chair, two years as Secretary of the Utah County Republican Party and four terms on the Republican State Central Committee. She also served a three-year appointment on the Utah County Planning Commission, including time as Chair.

She is a former educator in grades 4-12, teaching Japanese and Spanish. She worked on policy reform as the Community Engagement Director for Americans for Prosperity Utah in Lehi prior to the legislature and now works as a Business Evaluator for Western Governors University in the Graduate Business Ethics Department. She holds a Master's of Human Resource Management from the Keller Graduate School of Management and a Bachelor's from Brigham Young University.

In 2024, Sen. Balderree received the Friend of the Utah Taxpayer Award with a perfect score and the highest rating, 97%, in the legislature for defending liberties from the Libertas Institute.

Sen. Balderree and her husband, John, live in Saratoga Springs and have been married for 29 years. They are the proud parents of four children.
