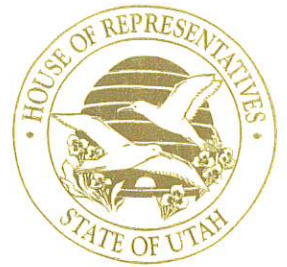

Janene Burton and Trevor John Crane

The Utah Legislature recognizes Janene Burton for her service to her community, her commitment to education, and her strength in the face of profound sacrifice.


Janene currently serves as a member of the Santa Clara City Council and demonstrated remarkable determination and civic engagement by winning her seat as a write-in candidate in the 2023 general election. Prior to her service in public office, she devoted 26 years to teaching high school United States history, shaping the lives of countless students through her dedication to education and her commitment to civic understanding. She has also served as the past president of the Women's Republican Club in Salt Lake City and was honored to represent the United States as Ms. Senior USA 2024.

Janene is the mother of four children and ten grandchildren, and she views her family as her greatest blessing and contribution. Her life reflects a deep commitment to faith, family, and community, values she has instilled in those around her through both her personal and public service.

On February 3, 2026, Janene received the heartbreaking news from the United States Embassy in Ukraine that her son, Trevor John Crane, was killed in Kharkiv, Ukraine. Trevor courageously served in defense of Ukraine for more than two and a half years as a member of the Heavy Weapons Company, 1st Battalion of the International Legion for the Defense of Ukraine, within the 131st Separate Mechanized Infantry Brigade. His willingness to stand in defense of freedom reflects a profound sense of duty, conviction, and sacrifice.

The Legislature recognizes the extraordinary strength, courage, and faith demonstrated by Janene and her family, and honors the life and sacrifice of Trevor John Crane, whose service and sacrifice will not be forgotten.

Now, therefore, be it known on this 23rd day of February 2026, the Utah Legislature recognizes Janene Burton for her service to her community, her enduring commitment to family and country, and expresses its deepest respect and appreciation for the life and sacrifice of her son, Trevor John Crane.




