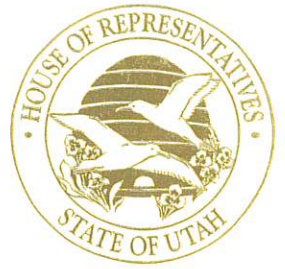

### *The Utah Land Use Task Force*

For more than twenty years, the Utah Land Use Task Force has operated as a voluntary working group composed of stakeholders representing a broad range of perspectives related to land use, development, housing, and local governance. Through dialogue and meetings, the Task Force has provided a forum for discussing, negotiating, and evaluating proposed changes to land use policies and practices.
