

Sen. Scott D. Sandall represents District 1, covering all of Box Elder County and parts of Cache and Tooele counties. He served in the Utah House of Representatives from 2015-2018 before joining the Senate in 2019. He currently serves as the Vice-Chair of Executive Appropriations.
