

Sen. Todd D. Weiler represents District 8, covering parts of Davis and Salt Lake counties, including West Bountiful, Bountiful, Woods Cross and North Salt Lake. He joined the Senate in 2012 and serves as the Senate parliamentarian. He chairs the Senate Judiciary, Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee, the Veterans and Military Affairs Commission and the Senate Judicial Confirmation Committee. Prior to his appointment to the Senate, he served on the Woods Cross City Council.

Sen. Weiler earned his bachelor's degree in business and his J.D. from the J. Reuben Clark Law School, both from Brigham Young University.
